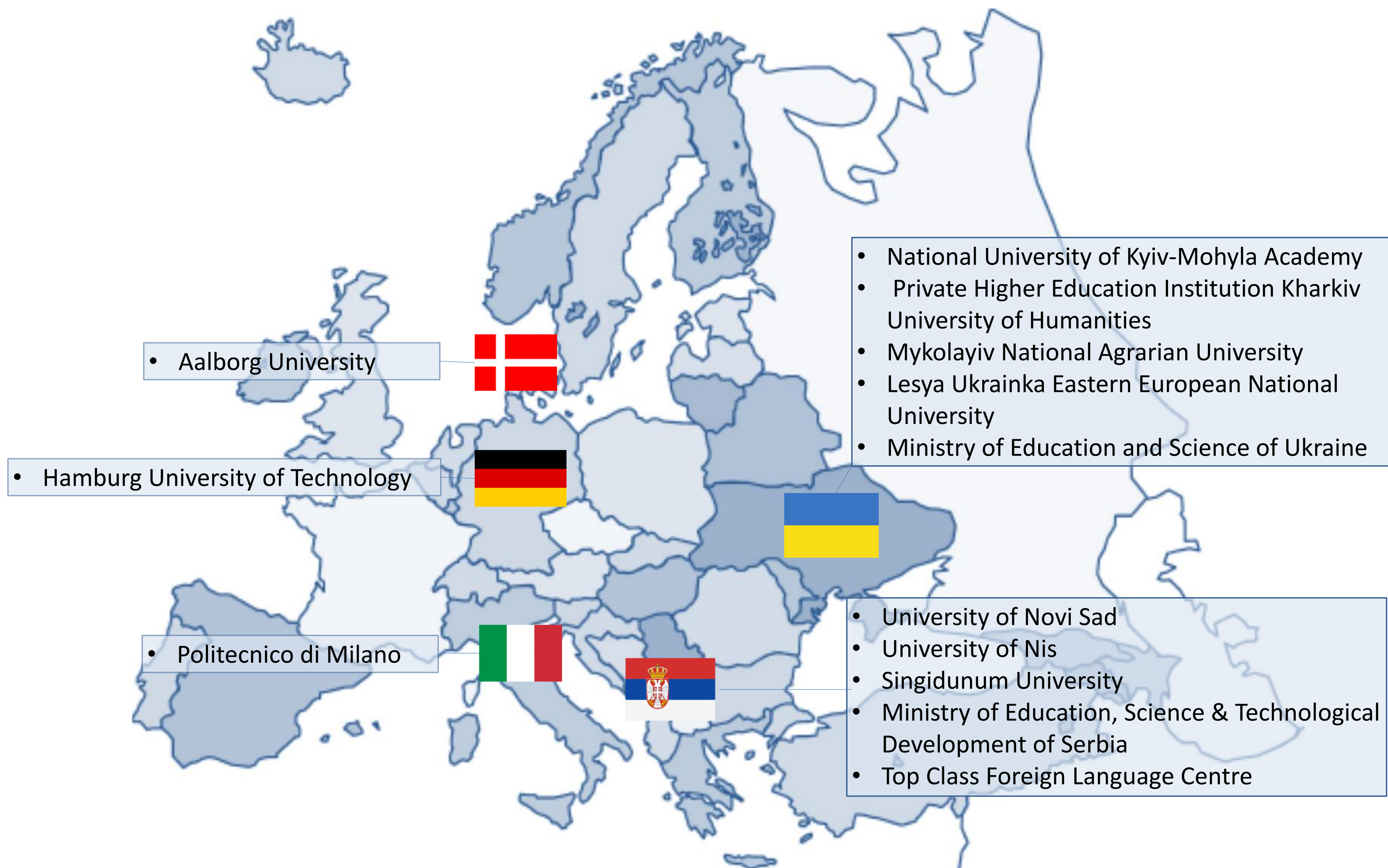




Call for applications for the virtual mobility run



About the virtual mobility run

- For Master and Bachelor students from Ukraine and Serbia.
- 8 students from each Partner Universities in Ukraine and Serbia will be selected in the virtual mobility run.
- 14 international teams of students from Ukraine and Serbia, from different subject fields.
- The teams will be working under the supervision of EU-Universities teaching staff (Germany, Italy, Denmark).

Duration and Learning activity of virtual mobility run

- The duration of the first virtual mobility run is 30 calendar days.
- The learning material will be provided on the course website and can be accessed at your convenient time.
- Students will experience working in the multicultural teams, together with the peers from other countries, as well as looking at the problem from perspectives of different subject fields with common understanding of lecture topics.
- Upon successful completion of all the tasks of the mobility run participants will be granted the certificates.

- How to improve academic English skills and effectively fight cultural barriers in multinational teams.

Who can apply?

- You are enrolled as a student in a full time **Master programme** or a **Bachelor student of 3rd and 4th study year** at the Partner Universities in Serbia and Ukraine.
- You can demonstrate a satisfactory academic performance.
- You have a high language proficiency in English (**at least B1 – intermediate level**).
- You can demonstrate a high level of motivation to be enrolled the virtual mobility run.
- At this particular moment, you cannot participate in the real international students' mobility programs due to certain constraints or other reasons.

- Motivation letter in English.
- Curriculum vitae (CV) in English.
- Enrollment certificate or similar document on current student status issued by home institution (English or local language of your home institution).
